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
The toolbar consists of Legend, Bookmark, Find an Address, Identify, Measure, and Print tools. Click on an icon to open the window that allows you to utilize a tool's functionality.

The More... button allows you to turn layers on and off similar to the legend. (turn Census Place layer on and off here)

Change base layer to Topographic, Streets, or Aerial Photography with these buttons.

Map Legend: Scroll through layers and check boxes next to layers to turn them on and off.

Navigation Information:



IMPORTANT: You can navigate through the map by using your mouse wheel to zoom in and out. You can move the map by simply clicking and dragging with your mouse. Alternatively, you can use the navigation toolbar to the right of the map.

Arrows pan, or move the map, north, south, east and west.

The globe resets the map extent.

Use arrows to change the map extent to your previous or next zoom level.

Use the zoom scale to increase or decrease the scale of the map.

Use the "hand" to pan, or move the map.

Use the "plus" and "minus" buttons to zoom in or out of the map by click the tool and then drawing a box.


Search Tool:

The district is highlighted in red and data for this district appears in the window.


To select a different district click the far left binoculars and repeat the steps mentioned above.

Bookmarks Tool:




Step 1: Click this icon to open the Bookmarks window.

Step 2: Click on a city to zoom to it instantly.

Find an Address Tool:




Step 1: Click this icon to open the Find an Address window.

Step 3: After locating an address, click the mailbox to locate another address.

Step 2: Type an address in the box and click the locate button to zoom to the address location.


Measure Tool:



Step 1: Click this icon to open the measure window.

Step 2: Click the show Measurements box then click a line, circle or rectangle to find the measurement of a length or area.

Print Tool:



Click this icon to open the print window.

Zoom to the area of the map you want to print and press print.
