<i>Name</i>	Country and Citizenship Element Standard												
<i>Description</i>	This document contains the basis for the creation of a country or citizenship data element standard for the grouping of people based upon their location within a country												
<i>Rationale</i>	Provides a set of guidelines in which the country or citizenship data elements can be uniformly defined, coded and maintained thereby allowing integration and interaction between state systems within Missouri												
<i>Benefits</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Used in statistical gathering of the population to observe and monitor the change in country of origin or citizenship data for the State of Missouri</li> <li>Provides a baseline for the monitoring and enforcement of country and citizenship related issues.</li> </ul>

Inter-governmental Migration Strategy Agencies creating new applications should attempt to adhere to the data elements standards when defining the data definitions unless it conflicts with their business requirements
