<i>Name</i>	Person Name Element Standard		
<i>Description</i>	Person names are characteristics that describe or identify an individual. The structure and organization of person names can vary due to cultural and ethnic diversity, family heritage, as well as gender, marital status, and religious affiliation. Some cultures incorporate compound family or last names (some hyphenated, others are non-hyphenated separate last names), multiple middle names (often due to religious affiliation, or family heritage), and variations of name component sequence (some cultures specify family or last name as the leading name component or include names from multiple generations).		
<i>Rationale</i>	Person name is a generic term referring to an individual person. When used in this context, person name should be recognized as a generic term since it does not differentiate between more specific types of identifiable individuals. These specific types would be defined in the business architecture such as business owner, birth name, married name, etc.		
<i>Benefits</i>	To provide consistency in names used to identify an individual person.
