GENERAL PRICING CONDITIONS

Please find below the pricing conditions for this proposal. These conditions govern all waste streams covered under this proposal. This proposal is submitted with the understanding that no additional terms or conditions not previously reviewed by Clean Harbors will be included by the State in any award documents or purchase orders issued.

Assumptions and Considerations

All waste profiling, manifests and labels will be provided at no charge.

All pricing presented in this proposal is based on Clean Harbors' ability to fully utilize all Clean Harbors approved TSDF's. If the State of Missouri wishes to reduce the number of sites approved for disposal, additional costs may be applied due to increased handling of wastes and reduced economies of scale.

Clean Harbors requires free and easy access to each pickup site. Drums must be in DOT shippable condition.

The transportation pricing assumes that Clean Harbors will be given 10 days advance notice, or is permitted to set the State of Missouri on a routine pickup schedule. Emergency shipments will be charged additionally, based on the availability of equipment and logistics.

Disposal Pricing Conditions

- 1.) All waste streams are coded with Clean Harbors Waste Classification Codes, which define the specifications for drummed and containerized wastes. A description of these codes is included in the bulk drum rate sheet. Waste not conforming to these specifications may be subject to additional costs.
- 2.) A completed waste profile sheet and sample, representative analysis or MSDS must be submitted prior to approval and scheduling.

5.) Demurrage Charges

Demurrage will not be charged for pickup of waste at State of Missouri sites up to and including 1 hour loading time. After 1 hour, the demurrage schedule of charges applies (see below).

Unloading demurrage will not be charged for wastes being delivered to Clean Harbors plants, unless a very significant generator-caused problem develops, such as improperly identified or non-conforming

waste, a missed time slot at a facility caused by a State of Missouri caused delay, or a chemical release as a result of a failed container. In this event, Clean Harbors will allow up to two (2) free hours of unloading.

Clean Harbors will provide separate quotations for any potential high-hazard work (e.g. peroxidized ethers, explosives, cylinders, etc.) upon request.

Time over eight (8) hours in the normal workday and all day Saturday is considered overtime and will be billed at 1.5 times the applicable straight time rate for all billable personnel unless otherwise quoted. Sunday and Holidays are considered premium time and will be billed at 2.0 times the applicable straight time rate for all billable personnel unless otherwise quoted.
